How to get there from here...

Scott Road in Surrey is your first aim, so get there how you wish. You can probably get there easist though by crossing the Patullo Bridge and turning right onto Scott Road just off the bridge. First method - continue past all the auto wreckers until you reach the Scott Rd. hill and stay in the right hand turn lane to go onto River Road. Then follow River Road for about 3 miles until you see McAdam Road on your left. Turn left and follow until you reach 10952 McAdam on your left hand side (near the end of the street). Second method - bypass River Road and head up the hill. Continue along Scott Road until you reach 84th Avenue. Turn right, continue through 4-way stop at 116th Street and the light at 112th. About 2 streets past 112th is Brooke. Turn right and continue until Brooke curves to the left - you curve to the right and you'll be on McAdam. Same address as above only on your right.
