MAYDAY & Where to Get It: The MAYDAY will be available at each META meeting this year to save on postage (and get You to the meeting!) I realize not everyone can make it to the Music Room at Moody Park on the 4th Wednesday of every month at 8:00 p.m. - just a reminder - and your copy will be sent to you, too. Just be aware that some of the news might be a little late.

Those of you who wish to contribute articles or information to the MAYDAY should also be aware that you must get these things to me well in advance as your message will only get to the members at the meeting or after.

### MONEY FOR M.E.T.A.

Recently, the Executive submitted a proposal to the Province of B.C., Ministry of Labour & Consumer Services for funds to support their program to fight substance abuse. As we are a non-profit organization concerned with safety in motorsport, it seemed like a good method to promote our club in conjunction with the principles of fighting drug and alcohol abuse (not to mention good PR for our sport). In any case, the Ministry granted us \$600 to assist us in increasing community participation in responsibility for the prevention of abuse, under the B.C. Community Action Program. This covers to the end of March 89 and so must be used by then. A proposal for the balance of 89 must be submitted by the end of February. We must show how we have used this year's funds to be eligible for a new grant. Unfortunately, the money has not arrived though plans are being executed on the best utilization. The aim is to have something prepared for the Motorsport Show, where we can reach people in the community, and a large number at that. Assuming we can convince the government of the value of our program and we get additional funds for 1989, the Executive would like some ideas for the use of the grant.

Some guidelines are:

- 1) could explore innovative prevention and treatment intervention in the community
- 2) increase community participation in prevention
- 3) develop a network of community action groups in each region of B.C.
- 4) identify local methods of preventing alcohol and drug abuse, which may have application to other B.C. communities

We cannot make any profit through these activities and the money cannot cover our administrative costs of any programs we already do such as training, car shows etc.

Of course, it couldn't hurt if we all do our part in setting a good example by not abusing drugs or alcohol ourselves!

So put your thinking caps on and give the Exec. some feedback. No matter how wild your idea may seem initially, there's a possibility it could be just what they're looking for.

Dear Motorsports Fan,

You are probably aware of the sad state of our motorsport facilities in the Fraser Valley and Lower Mainland: Action Raceway shut down by Government action in 1985, Mission Raceway closed the same way some years ago, Westwood closing soon, because the Government is selling the land for residential real estate development.

For the past 6 years, various motorsport groups have been lobbying the Provincial Government to assist in the development of a world class motorsport park so that we can have a place to gather, to race, to slalom and to meet.

Our company has proposed a motorsport park in the Southwest corner of Matsqui, in an area of exhausted gravel pits, and we need your support to make the project go. Our job right now, is to convince the Mayor and Council of Matsqui, and Elwood Veitch the Provincial Minister of Regional Economic Development, that motorsport fans want this project, that we are decent sensible people who also pay taxes, that we deserve a home for our sport, just as hockey or tennis players get facilities for their sports. What we want you to do is to write to the mayor of Matsqui, and to Elwood Veitch and tell them you support the Motorsport Park. I know it takes some time, and it's easy to forget a request like this. It may seem to you like somebody else will do it if you don't, but let me tell you that this is our *last chance!* If we can't convince the Province and the city of Matsqui to let us build this park, there won't be another opportunity anywhere in the Fraser Valley. Please don't let your chance to continue enjoying racing slip away. Here are the names and addresses:
