Lunched will be provided as well as water, but be prepared for both hot and cold weather.



#### RACE DIARY

#### I M S A - PORTLAND JULY 26-28, 1991

#### TOLD BY THE PRESIDENT OF M E T A

Thursday 25th. Left Delta very late 8.00 p.m., heading towards Portland. Arrival time 2.00 a.m. approx at the Fetterman Lodge.

Friday 26th. 6.30 a.m. Registration at the Red Lion Inn arriving at the track by 7.30 a.m. Morning meeting and be ready for racing by 9.00 a.m. Turn 4. Great practice sessions with hot weather finishing the day by approx 5.30 p.m. Had a couple of suds then the whole Canadian gang went to dinner at the Matterhorn Restaurant. Excellent food with cheese fondue included in the price. Hit the sack by 11.00 p.m.

Saturday 27th. 6.30 a.m. breakfast at the International House of Pancakes with track meeting at 7.30 a.m. 9.00 a.m. practice sessions start with all groups. Great racing with the GTP cars qualifying one at a time. Track record broken three times, winner Intrepid built in the USA. Great eh?

- 4.00 p.m. the Firehawk Endurance race with a total of 51 cars on grid. Excellent racing for three hours.
- 7.30 p.m. Barbecue at the track great food and fun. Hit the sack by 11.00 p.m. exhausted but happy.

Sunday 28th. 6.30 a.m. Breakfast at the I H O P arriving for the morning meeting at 8.00 a.m. 8.15 a.m. Gala Performance of the M E T A Shuffle. It got rave reviews! It was the talk of the workers all day. 9.00 a.m. racing started. Great racing throughout the day. - 7.00 p.m. departure for home with dinner at Shari's at Centralia. Meet the whole Canadian gang.






