

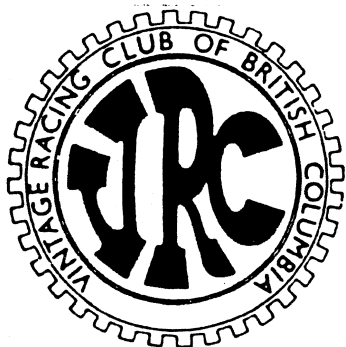
Monday morning found some of us exploring and panning for gold in the Similkameen River, (found a few flakes, but nothing to retire on) and by lunch-time the camp began to break up.
