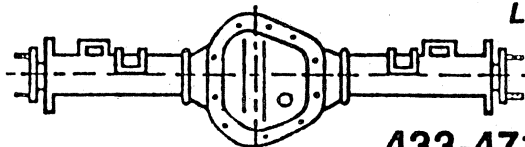
#### FOR THOSE WITH EXTRA TIME ON THEIR HANDS....

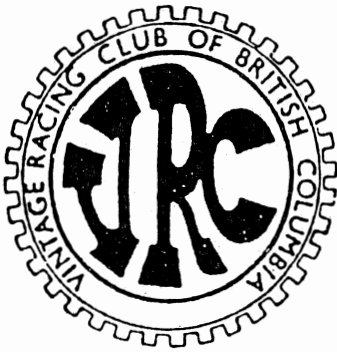
## ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING
