





## META RECORDS & ARCHIVES; AD-HOC COMMITTEE REPORT

Committee Representatives: Joe Proud, Graham Moffat, Dave Bell, Steven Bibby

**Objective:** To review, organize and report on the condition of the records and archives.

**Findings:** The committee reviewed the following files which are currently stored at Roger Salomon & Ann Peters home. The files and their contents are in good physical shape, and fit within two drawers of a lateral filing cabinet. A general description of the content of each file, along with a list of the missing information (if any), has been included. No records from 1998 were reviewed.

- 1) Correspondence Files: Files containing all known incoming and outgoing correspondence for a given year. Individual files dated from 1973 to 1997 are separated into calendar year. *Missing from the records are all correspondence from 1980, 1984, 1985 & 1986*.
- 2) Meeting Minutes: Minutes of executive and general meetings from 1973 to 1997. *Missing are the minutes of all meetings in 1983* (Individual meeting minutes for each month were not determined, but will be reviewed if we are unable to locate copies of each "Mayday"). *Attendance sheets from meetings were not available in most files*.
- **3) Mayday:** Original newsletters filed by month/edition dating back to 1976. Several editions are missing, and Joe Proud will inspect his personal file of Maydays in an attempt to fully supplement the missing records. A list of any Mayday(s) which remain missing after Joe's inspection will be posted along with a request for member assistance.
- **4)** Constitution(s)/Policy & Procedures: A copy of the proposed and adopted (1980) constitution, along with the P&P (The minutes of the January 1973 general meeting indicate that a constitution was reviewed and approved in January 1973. Our committee has been unable to find a copy which indicates that the 1973 constitution was registered in Victoria).
- **5) Financial Statements and Auditor's Reports:** Official (Income Tax) information dating from 1973 to 1991 (the period from 1992 to present remains with the Treasurer). The contents of these files were not reviewed.
- 6) Registrar of Companies: Contains the original company registration documents from 1981.
- 7) Worker's Manual: The current and previous worker's manual(s), along with training guides and samples of guides from other clubs. A copy of the current manual is also on diskette.
- 8) Newspaper Clippings: Various articles related to racing, dating back several years.
- 9) Quizes: A copy of fun filled questions and games related to racing and the Mayday.
- **10) Turn 2 Worker's Manual:** The original manual from Westwood's turn 2.
