Track Tips for the Racing Novice

1. Racing isn't dangerous; Crashing is dangerous.

3. Learn from the mistakes of others: you will never live long enough to make all of them yourself.

4. To win, you must first finish; to finish, you must first start. To start, you must first spend an inordinate amount of time and money.

5. Drive your own race. Others will be all too happy to tell you what you did wrong.

6. Every driver knows the 3 simple tricks for winning races; ask your closest competitors to share theirs.

7. An oversteering car generates higher slip angles at the rear than the front. Keep all slip angles under 360 degrees.

8. Wear a full-face helmet. It will be easier to hide your fear.

9. Choose a close-fitting racing seat. Do not get it brown.

[The 6 Hours of Olympia \(Race Report\)](#)

Yesterday, January 23rd, Apex Karting hosted the second annual "6 hours of Olympia" worker appreciation endurance race, which raises money for the corner workers of the ICSCC. For me, it was the first endurance race at Apex Karting that I have Race Directed for, and all in all, I think it went well. Primarily, it is because of the hard work put in by the mechanics and tuners at Apex, which allowed for us to have very few mechanical issues, and the ones that we did have were not preventable. Kudos to Daryl and George.

Things in the pits ran smoothly as well, thanks to the efforts of my Head Marshall Phil and both my Pit Bosses Alex and Colby. These guys performed excellent under pressure, and things went flawless in the pits because of them. This allowed me to pay closer attention to the racing on the track, which there was plenty of...

Things kicked off with qualifying, which actually was an effort to start second, as the pole had been awarded to "Martini Racing" ("Martini Racing & the Olive Eating Society") via a benefit auction for the workers. The main catch for the teams was that although most had practiced leading up to the event, they were now taking to the track in the reverse direction for the first time, and only had 3 laps to learn not only the track, but the kart they were in as well. Team "Fear This" shined brightly here, clocking a time almost a half a second clear from the competition, followed by team "Mission" ("We're on a mission from God") and Team "BLF" (Big, Loud, and Fast) to complete the first two rows.

Martini Racing would hold the point for the first several laps, putting in consistent times, and showing a good 6-hour race pace, but it was team "Eye Patch" who started fifth, that was making the big charge. With Ryan Heironymous behind the wheel, team Eye Patch worked its way to second by lap six, then took the fight to Martini, slowly reeling them in, and eventually stealing the top spot away on lap 37. These two teams continued to pull away from the field, keeping the top spots even after the first sets of pit stops.

Their reign at the front was not absolute however, as a little before the halfway point Eye Patch relinquished the lead, and Martini Racing a slow descent down the standings. As the top two teams stumbled, two teams rose to the challenge: FBR ("FBR Motorsports") and team "Fear This". These two teams would trade the top spot back and forth for a few laps, but it would eventually be FBR showing the way into the later stages of the race, becoming one of the primary contenders for the win. Eye Patch, having fell to 3rd shortly before the halfway point, made a change in strategy, and double stunted Heironymous to start reeling in the leaders, and give them a shot at the win.

The strategy worked. With a little over an hour remaining, Eye Patch re-took the lead via a pit stop by the leading FBR team. In the final 100 laps Eye patch would extend it's lead over the trailing FBR team, helped tremendously by making one less pit stop. The timing of their last fuel stop had turned what seemed like a sure win, into a nail biter for team lead Curtis Creager, as their team was desperately close to running out of fuel in the closing laps. Further adding to the drama was the fact that, aided by a strong horse underneath them, FBR had started to gain on the leading team, even gaining their lap back to come within about a half lap of the point. They too were playing the fuel mileage game, hoping that their rivals chances would end in tears...

FBR Motorsports would indeed make it on fuel, but so would team Eye Patch, crossing the line first to win the 2010 edition of the 6 Hours of Olympia. As defending champs of last years race, this makes it two in a row for the Eye Patch squad, placing the target square on their backs for 2011.

Thanks again to everyone for coming out to race and spectate, the "Ground Pounder Drivers Association" for putting on the event, and of course the ICSCC workers for which the event benefits. We look forward to seeing you all sooner than later, and to the next edition of the race.
