There are approximately 300 hotel rooms within a ten-mile radius. Some are high end, others very affordable. Also, many Bed and Breakfast operations as well, so you have a choice. The Ridge is just 1.5 hours from Seattle, 2 hours from Portland and 4.5 hours from Vancouver B.C. From I-5: On I-5 in Olympia take Exit 104 and merge onto US 101 N towards Shelton/Port Angeles. After approximately 5.9 miles take exit to stay on US 101 N towards Shelton/Port Angeles After 17.3 miles take Left onto Dayton Airport Rd WA 102 towards the Washington State Corrections Facility. After 1.5 miles turn right on W Eells Hill Rd, Track will come up on the right hand side, can't miss it.

Parking is allowed at the turns. If you don't wish to park on the turns we will provide transport.



37TH ANNUAL 8 HOURS OF THE CASCADES SATURDAY, OCTOBER 20th 2012 @ P.I.R

There are a few changes to this year's 8 Hours of the Cascades.

New class structure – This structure should greatly increase the competitiveness of many more cars!!! It also eliminates in some classes the advantage gained by preparing an "endurance" car – The new structure is designed to make normal sprint race cars competitive.

New price structure – An entry fee for the car and then a per driver fee. Total entry fee will end up being very similar to 2011. 2 - 3 driver teams will see slightly lower entry fees compared to 2011 while 4 and up driver teams will see slightly higher entry fees compared to 2011 (assuming an early entry and not taking into account credits earned from the mini enduros).

An early entry fee discount – Enter by 9/20/12 and receive a discount of \$100.00

Cascade One Hour Mini Enduro participants receive credit towards the 8 Hours of the Cascades based upon points earned in those races. Entry fee credits equal up to \$102.00 per driver. Actual discounts for each driver are posted at www.cascadesportscarclub.org under FAST Specialties Mini Enduro results on the "Racing" page – scroll to the bottom. Discounts will be applied by the Race Registrar at time of registration.

Prize Money structure – The more cars in a class the larger the payout is to the class winner. In addition, \$750.00 in Bonus Prize Money for a class within a class field of 8 or more cars. Example: If eight or more PRO3 cars are entered in E2 - \$750 will be split between the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place finishers (60/30/10 percentage split). The bonus prize money is in addition to the other prize money.

But racing wise, it's been a fantastic season so far, with the new car demonstrating reasonable toughness and the engine competition finally heating up.

There are a lot of things that I wish I could tell you about 2012, but we're still working out details with RaceOn that had been established months earlier for the 2011 inaugural running, and I'm afraid I'll just have to pass that information forward as it becomes settled. We expect to have a Thursday evening social event again, and hope to be able to host a more proper party on Saturday, but my host crew is still working on that.

A few things to be aware of. Once again, we will use the WDCR "Pro Worker" webpage to distribute information and reference materials. The URL is http://proworker.wdcr-scca.org

If you haven't been out to an Indycar event yet this season, please do review the 2012 Indycar F&C Guidelines as there are some new instructions and flag displays in use this season. We'll go over them again at the Friday morning meeting, but getting a jump on your homework will help eliminate any weekend confusion.

Our intention this year was to make it more convenient for you to dump your gear in town, get cleaned up, and walk to evening festivities. For your convenience, we have reserved a block of rooms at the Brookshire Suites in downtown Baltimore (one block north from Turn 1) at the discounted rate of \$139/nt plus taxes. To book at this rate, you must telephone your reservation to the Brookshire at 410-625-1300 no later than July 30, and use the block name "WDCR". A cursory examination of <u>priceline.com</u> and <u>roomkey.com</u> indicates that as of July 20, individual rooms can still be had in the \$70 range at a couple of hotels in greater Baltimore, but none of them are closer than 1.5 miles away, and inexpensive double occupancy rooms are otherwise in short supply.

Information will follow about the registration location this year. We expect to be in the Indycar credential room this year, which will almost certainly be at one of the hotels adjacent to the circuit.

I expect to keep signups open somewhat later than usual this year, but please, please, PLEASE, fill out the form as soon as you can so that we can have some idea of how many marshals will be coming, and so that we can get a head start on assignments.

Again, I thank you for your interest in the 2012 Grand Prix of Baltimore, and hope to see you next month!




